Sir/Madam,

With a view to give immediate assistance to the bereaved household in the event of death of the bread-winner under NFBS, I am directed to inform you that the following points may be considered during enquiry process:

1. Date of death
2. Date of submission of application (within 3 months)
3. Time frame to report from Panchayats to BDO → 7 days
4. Time frame to report from BDO to DPRDO → 7 days
5. Payment to be made within next 15 days (subject to availability of fund)

It is further to say that as Govt. of West Bengal has adopted SECC data for NSAP, henceforth during enquiry of application for one time assistance under NFBS, SECC criteria & deprivation level of the household is also to verify. The concerned enquiry officer should certify that very household does not fall under Auto Exclusion criteria.
